PETITION AGAINST AUTOMATIC ENDING OF LIFE- There are moves afoot to impose a 3-day limit on the continuation of basic care of the dying (e.g. withdrawing fluids) as directed by medical advice. The implications of this are not only immoral but also extremely distressing for the patient. To be left to die of dehydration is cruel. We are asked to sign a petition (to be found on the table in church) opposing this further step down the road to complete euthanasia.

JUNE PICNIC AND CONCERT AT CHRIST THE KING - As well as the special day on 21 August, another event to mark the 50th Anniversary will be a **Picnic Lunch followed by a Concert** given by musicians directed by local music teacher Kathy Laughton, on **Sunday 26 June**.
