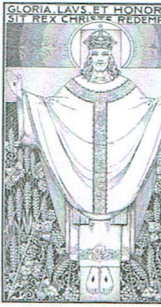

**YEAR FOR PRIESTS 2018-2019**  
From June 8<sup>th</sup> until the following June there will be a year of prayer and reflection on the priesthood in dioceses throughout England & Wales. The special prayer cards are available on the table in church.

**DAY FOR LIFE** - Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> June has been set aside to pray for and offer support to agencies which protect all right to life. We might think it a foregone conclusion that life is still regarded as sacred. Not so. Although we have removed the death penalty -even for the most horrifying of crimes- the state does not consider that in every case, the life of an innocent unborn child should be protected. When it suits, all kinds of alternative words are used to describe the child in the womb so as to disguise the reality of abortion, which can take place for any number of reasons. The welfare of the child can't be one of them. No one who has regard for the ultimate welfare of humanity should be complacent about the reality of what is at stake here.

**ADOREMUS** - The official title of a Eucharistic Congress taking place in Liverpool from 7<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> September 2018. Events like this are usually held in different countries every four years. They are meant to emphasize the importance of the Holy Eucharist in the life of the Church and in the spiritual welfare of every Catholic.
