2017 – A YEAR OF CENTENARIES – This year marks the one hundredth anniversary of the Russian Revolution. It also marks the five hundredth anniversary of Martin Luther's protestant revolt in Germany. In their very different ways these commemorations will be recalled and commented upon. Both had consequences of global significance. Depending on opposing points of view they will be viewed favourably or with deep scepticism. Exactly a century on, the centenary of the Apparition of Our Lady to the children at Fatima still exerts a fascination as well as a curiosity with many. The message was both timely and reflected a growing anxiety about peace and stability for the future. The past 100 years has seen a depressing increase in conflict. The message of Fatima is still relevant.
