

## SAINTS OF THIS WEEK-

Sixtus II – One of the early Popes he defended the validity of all Christian baptisms. He and his six deacons were martyred at Rome in 258AD.

Dominic –(1170-1221) Spanish friar who founded the Dominicans to be an effective preaching ministry against a major heresy of that time known as Catharism; in many ways similar to today's Jehovah Witnesses. The Dominicans (always known as Blackfriars) founded the first colleges in Oxford and were renowned for their theological and spiritual insights.

**Teresa Benedicta** – (1891-1942) A Jewish writer and mystic named Edith Stein, she converted and became a Carmelite nun. Arrested by the Nazis in Holland, she died in Auschwitz.

Laurence – (d. 258AD) Roman deacon martyred in the same persecution by Emperor Valerian which caused the death of Pope Sixtus II. He became a very popular saint, with two major basilicas in Rome dedicated to him and many other churches throughout Europe and later in other continents.

Clare – (1194-1253) A friend of St Francis, she followed his example of poverty and religious life. Her order of Poor Clares is still to be found in many places quietly following the rule of their founder.
