#### **TEMPTATION IN THE DESERT**

Jesus is "led by the Spirit" into the wilderness. In biblical terms the place where God tests His holy ones. In His humanity Our Lord was tempted in unique ways and we see how He dealt with it. The first temptation is about exclusive reliance on material things. He responds with a quote from Deut 8:3; a reference to the lack of faith shown by the people of Israel as they journeyed towards the Promised Land. The second temptation is about trust in God. Jesus refers to Deut. 6;16; an example of resentment shown by the people, refusing to let God demonstrate His power and providence towards them. The third temptation is about the corruption of earthly power. This means leaving God out of the equation when it comes to finding solutions for the world's many problems. In all these temptations the aim of Satan is to cause Jesus to see an easier, worldly way of attracting followers; a way that involves spectacle and the use of His powers to relieve human misery without any cost to Himself. Beyond every one of these temptations is of course the ultimate acceptance by Jesus of the hard road that would take Him to Calvary. Only thus could death and the Devil's hold over mankind be destroyed. We all need to learn that what God wills for us is always best but we often don't see that or seek a way to avoid the challenge; the hard road that leads to peace.

## DOING THAT BIT EXTRA FOR LENT

Those under 18 and those over 60 are exempt from fasting. But there are treats we can forego. At the same time prayer and almsgiving are possible in many situations. A source of blessing can be a visit to the church for 10 minutes of prayer at any time during the day, or even the briefest round of the Stations of the Cross (the meditations may be as long or as short as you can manage) and you can also mediate on them in your own home. Mass on a weekday calls for some discipline but is its own reward. The church is open from 8am -6pm and Our Lord is always present in the Blessed Sacrament, awaiting your visit.
