SAINTS OF THIS WEEK-

Bede (673-735) Monk, historian and biblical scholar, who lived and died at Jarrow, Northumberland.

Philip Neri (1519-1595) – Founder of the Oratory Congregation. A saint of spiritual influence way beyond Rome and the century in which he lived.

Augustine of Canterbury (d. 604)
He was Superior of the Benedictine monks who were sent by Pope Gregory I to convert the Saxons in Kent. For more than 1000 years Canterbury cathedral was served by monks.
