SAINTS OF THE WEEK – St Bede – (673-735) Monk and historian who lived and wrote at Wearmouth in the NE.
St Philip Neri (1515-1595) Founder of the Oratorian Congregation. A humorous and saintly priest and pastor whose influence helped to convert and sustain the faith of many Romans at a time of terrible devastation and decadence for the Church.
St Augustine of Canterbury (d. 605) Sent by Pope St Gregory the Great to convert the Saxons in Kent he achieved notable success, becoming the first Archbishop of that see and establishing strong links between Rome and England which lasted for nearly 1,000 years.
