SAINTS OF THIS WEEK-

Cyril of Alexandria (376-444). Outstanding bishop of his generation who defended the doctrine of Mary as Mother of God as defined by the Council of Ephesus in 431.

Irenaeus (130-200)- Bishop of Lyons. His writings are valued as representing an excellent example of early teaching and doctrinal development.

Peter & Paul - the two founding figures of the early Church whose presence in Rome bestowed eternal fame on that city as it became the centre of global Christianity.

First Martyrs of Rome - from 64AD the first Christians to suffer for the faith in reign of Emperor Nero, began to be commemorated and regarded as shining examples of fidelity.

Oliver Plunket(1629-81). Archbishop of Armagh. He was falsely accused of treason and hanged, drawn and quartered at Tyburn in London in 1681.

JUNE - MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART

The devotion to the Heart of Jesus was a response to an extreme hard-line view that denied the possibility of salvation to all but an exclusive group of people. The reality is that God's mercy is without limit and in Christ we recognise and see it personified, in word and sacrifice.
