St Thomas Becket – (1118-1170) Murdered in Canterbury Cathedral on this day in 1170 at the behest of King Henry II. Pope St Sylvester (d. 335AD). The only Pope of that name, he lived to see the end of persecution and the first public buildings in Rome as Primatial See of the Universal Church. The Motherhood of the Blessed Virgin Mary- a celebration of Mary as the chosen one of God, who provided the human ancestry and nature of Jesus, the Second Person of the Most Blessed Trinity.

THE HOLY FAMILY – A famous painting by the Spanish artist Bartolomé Murillo depicts the Holy Family of Nazareth with, above them, the Most Blessed Trinity. It is, as it were, a comparison of the secret of unity of human love, fidelity and intimacy manifested in the relationship of Jesus, Mary and Joseph with that mysterious divine intimacy and creative love that exists in the communion of Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Genuine love always radiates outwards and embraces everything that is intended for the welfare and good of the beloved. It is never satisfied with half-measures or tires of seeking to extend its capacity to give and to receive whatever will benefit and support the other. The Holy Family held a unique and precious secret that perhaps could never be spoken of without risk or threat of exposure to blasphemy and its consequent punishment. While all three lived together and until Jesus emerged with his true identity of God in human form it had to remain unspoken and within the family unit. Nazareth in Galilee, distant from Jerusalem and Bethlehem was anonymous and safer in which to live and for Jesus to grow up securely, under the human guidance of two people, who, because of their singular virtues and piety were ideally chosen for the task by God. They were not a typical family in that sense. But they have many lessons to teach us. The lessons of domestic piety, humility, silence, perfect love, total obedience, practical fidelity and the value of human craftsmanship and artistry. Of all the relics that may exist, connected with the life and death of Jesus, it has always surprised me that no one has ever produced something made by his hands. Now that would be a most precious item of inestimable value and interest, to be venerated, exhibited and cherished.
