Falsely accused of a plot to overthrow Charles II, found guilty by a rigged jury and then hanged, drawn & quartered at Tyburn. He was the last Catholic martyr to suffer in England. **St Thomas, Apostle**. Famous for his doubt he is revered as the apostle of India.
