SAINTS OF THIS WEEK-

Thomas – Usually known as the apostle who doubted but his doubts provided a confirmation of the reality of the resurrection of Jesus. He is believed to have preached the gospel in India where he suffered martyrdom Elizabeth of Portugal (1271-1336) Spanish wife of King Denis she was renowned in her lifetime for piety: as a widow, became a Franciscan tertiary. Oxfordshire Martyrs – 2 priests and 2 laymen who suffered for the faith in Oxford on this day in 1589 in the reign of Queen Elizabeth I.

Maria Goretti (1890-1902) A twelveyear-old who resisted a violent attack on her virtue and died as a result of wounds received. Her attacker later repented and was present in St Peter's at her canonization in 1950.

JULY-MONTH OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD
