Pope St Leo the Great- (440-61). Defender both of doctrine and of Rome itself which was spared by Attila the Hun after meeting with Leo. Martin of Tours-(316-97). Outstanding bishop whose fame caused two city churches in London to be named after him. Only one survives - St Martin in the Fields. St Josaphat (1580-1623) Ukranian martyr bishop whose death was instrumental in ending disunity in the Ukranian Church.
