<p><b>FEAST DAYS THIS WEEK – Dedication of the Lateran Basilica</b> (324) The first public church to be built in Rome after the end of the period of persecution. It is still the Cathedral Church of Rome. <b>Pope St Leo the Great-</b> (440-61). Defender both of doctrine and of Rome itself which was spared by Attila the Hun after meeting with Leo. <b>Martin of Tours-</b> (316-97). Outstanding bishop whose fame caused two city churches in London to be named after him.
