SAINTS OF THIS WEEK-

Maximilian Kolbe (1894-1941) – Polish priest of the Franciscan Order who had a great devotion to Our Lady. Has interned in Auschwitz and died of starvation in place of the father of a family.

Stephan of Hungary (969-1038) The county's Patron Saint, he was an exceptionally pious and successful ruler of his nation, unifying it and bringing it fully into the Catholic fold.

Jean Eudes (1601-1680)He was one of several holy priests who made France a constant source of devotional and religious inspiration in a century of Catholic revival, following the wars of religion.
