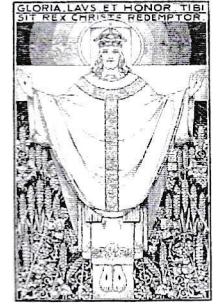

Devotion to Mary is especially evident in this first month of the summer. Nature is in bloom and flowers are in plenty to adorn our shrines and images of the Blessed Virgin. The Rosary is said regularly in our churches and in May we also add the Litany of Our Lady.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK -

Matthias - We read in the Acts of the Apostles how he was chosen to replace Judas. He had been a disciple of Jesus from earlier on and had proved his fidelity and dedication. He was recorded as having preached in Judea and then in Cappadocia (a region of what is now Turkey). His relics were brought by St Helena (mother of Emperor Constantine) from the Holy land to Trier in Germany, at that time an imperial city of the Roman Empire. Later on a Benedictine abbey dedicated to him - which still exists- was founded in that city.

Pope St John I -Elected in 523 he was imprisoned by Theodoric, King of Italy who mistakenly accused him of treason. He died in 526.

Dunstan - (909-988) - One of the great Anglo-Saxon Archbishops of Canterbury whose influence for reform and piety caused him to be recognised as a saint soon after his death.
