

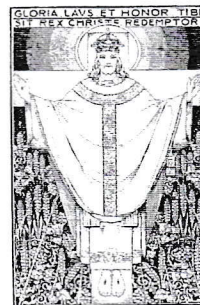

**SAINTS & FEASTS THIS WEEK**

**Teresa of Avila** 1515-1582. A woman of incredible energy and initiative, she went all over Spain reforming and founding Carmelite convents. Her spiritual writings have also earned her the title of Doctor of the Church.

**Hedwig** 1174-1243 – Bavarian duchess renowned for her charity. After being widowed she became a Cistercian nun.

**Margaret Mary** 1647-1690. Nun of the Order of the Visitation, her visions at Paray-le-Monial in Burgundy led to greater devotion to the Sacred Heart.

**Ignatius.** Followed St Peter as 2<sup>nd</sup> Bishop of Antioch in Syria. His writings are among the earliest theological studies.

**Luke** – disciple of Paul and evangelist (he also wrote the NT Acts of the Apostles). It is to him that we owe the account of the birth of Our Lord.

**Frideswide.** Saxon princess who founded and abbey in Oxford where she is still patron saint of the city and university.

**John de Brebeuf & Isaac Jogues** – French Canadian Jesuits who were martyrs in the 17<sup>th</sup> century.

**Paul of the Cross** 1694-1775 Founder of the Passionist Order of priests.
