

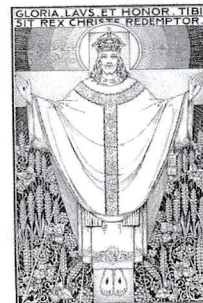

OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

Mount Carmel features in the Old Testament as the place of the triumph of the prophet Elijah over the false priests of Baal (1 Kings: 18). It was a sacred site throughout the period of Israel's development as a people of the covenant. At the time of the Crusades in the 11th century a group of hermits came to live on Mt Carmel and followed a rule written for them by the Patriarch of Jerusalem. Gradually the Order spread all over Europe; their distinctive white cloak gaining them the name of "Whitefriars". Many great saints have been members of the order. The Feast of Our Lady of Mt Carmel is of English origin according to a revelation to St Simon Stock and connected with the scapular. The Carmelite image of Our Lady and the feast have become hugely popular in parts of Mediterranean Europe and the Americas.

The Brown Scapular of Carmel, the most popular of all small scapulars worn round the neck, is traced back to a vision in 1251 of Our Lady by St Simon Stock, in which she promised him that it would be "a scapular of your Order as a badge of my confraternity, and for you and all Carmelites a special sign of grace; whoever dies in this garment will not suffer everlasting fire. It is a sign of salvation, a safeguard in danger, a pledge of peace and of the covenant." It is usually given a special blessing before being worn.

HYMNS ON SUNDAY

We are experimenting at 10 & 11.30am Masses on Sunday with new hymns sung to familiar tunes. The words of many of these hymns will therefore be unfamiliar to most. The aim is to increase our repertoire and begin to appreciate the rich variety of well-written hymns that can express themes from the scripture readings and also assist us in spiritual reflection and celebration at Mass.
