### FEASTS & SAINTS THIS WEEK:

Margaret Mary (1647-90) - Visionary sister who helped spread devotion to the Sacred Heart against those who sought to exclude from mercy all but the most austere among the faithful.

Ignatius of Antioch (d. 107) Very early Syrian martyr and theologian, some of whose writings have survived. Luke - Greek physician and friend & disciple of St Paul; his gospel reflects the central role of Mary as well as emphasis on mercy, poverty, prayer

Frideswide (680-735) - Saxon princess who founded an abbey in Oxford, of which city she is still patron saint. Her relics are still buried in the cathedral. though in 1558 they were deliberately mixed up with the bones of the wife of a Swiss Calvinist professor.

Paul of the Cross (1694-1775) -Founder of the Passionist Order. They were much sought after as preachers and were prominent in the Catholic revival in England in 19th century.
