

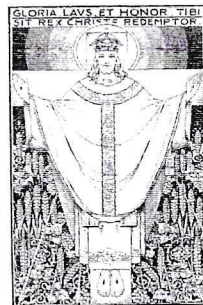

SAINTS & FEASTS THIS WEEK

Robert Bellarmine - 1542-1621 - Born in Montepulciano, Italy, he eventually joined the Jesuits and was later made a Cardinal. His writings were chiefly along lines of explaining Canon Law in the context of the challenge of the protestant revolt.

Theodore - 601-690. Archbishop of Canterbury from 669 until his death, he was born in Tarsus (in what is now Turkey, but was then part of the eastern Roman Empire). He brought organization, reform and energy to the emerging Anglo-Saxon church of that time and is regarded as one of the greatest archbishops of Canterbury.

Januarius - 4th century martyr bishop of Benevento in Italy. A reliquary containing his dried blood still liquefies miraculously at certain times of the year.

Andrew Tim Tae-gon ; First Korean priest who suffered for the faith in the 19th century. He is the first of many martyrs of that country who suffered for their faith.

Matthew - Aka Levi, he was the tax-collector who became a disciple and wrote one of the four Gospels. He is said to have preached in Persia, where he was martyred.
