SAINTS & FEASTS THIS WEEK Presentation of Our Lady – An ancient feast highly regarded in the Eastern Church. It celebrates Mary's dedication to God, which foreshadowed her acceptance to be the Mother His Son.

Cecilia – A Roman lady of noble family who was martyred for the faith in the reign of Emperor Marcus Aurelius (161-180). Her family home became a basilica and is one of the most beautiful of Rome's oldest churches. More than 1200 years after her death, her body was found incorrupt. Her shrine is beneath the altar. Clement – (d. 97) 4th Pope whose letter

to the Corinthians acknowledges his universal jurisdiction over the Church. He was exiled to hard labour and later thrown into the sea. The church dedicated to him in Rome is very ancient and artistic, and was originally built over a pagan temple –which can still be visited underground of the present church.

Andrew Dung Lac - (d. 1839) A Vietnamese priest who was martyred along with 116 Catholics. During the 19th century at least 300,000 in Vietnam were executed for their faith. Many more died in the 20th century. Yet, the Church not only survived there but is still growing.
