#### WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY

From 18th -25th we acknowledge the divisions that separate Christians but also remember what we have in common. The followers of Jesus are persecuted not because they are bad people but because they represent a threat to tyranny and evil ideology. Our divisions are a comfort to those who despise our faith. So it is essential to pray for unity. It would be pointless to pretend that there is little that a few tweaks here and there could not put right. The reality is more complex and deep-seated. Fervent and devout Christians on all sides of the divide hold firm principles and often measure what they believe as the truth in opposition to what they believe is false in the practice or teaching of others. The origin of division too is often political and rooted in state control and selfinterest. What we pray for is not compromise and complacency but a genuine coming together that is based on a common tradition of faith embracing unbroken links with the Apostolic Church. As things look that is probably a long way off. But we don't just depend on human negotiation to gain the prize of unity. We must ask the Lord in His good time to heal the wounds that human folly, sin and pride have inflicted on the Church of Christ over the centuries.
