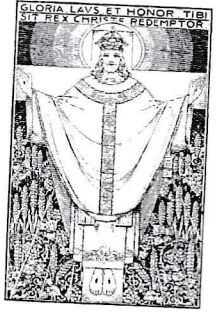

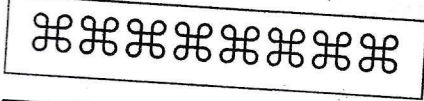

SAINTS OF THE WEEK -
Rita (1381-1457). Entering religious life after being widowed, she gained a reputation for holiness of life and a saint to turn to in impossible situations.
Bede (673-735). A monk of Jarrow monastery he wrote a history of Christianity in England and other spiritual commentaries. He was famous in his own lifetime for sanctity and scholarship.
Philip Neri (1515-1595) His life coincided with the century of the beginning and the spread of Protestantism. Born in Florence he moved to Rome, was ordained a priest and went on to found the Congregation of the Oratory. Something of a holy eccentric, he appealed to many of the young, helping to reform the clergy of Rome. He often met with the young seminarians of the English College studying for the priesthood and praised their courage and dedication. Blessed John Henry Newman chose to found an Oratory and a school (now in Woodcote) in Birmingham. Houses of the Oratory also exist in London, Bournemouth, York, Cardiff, and Oxford, as well as USA & Canada.
