### FEASTS & SAINTS THIS WEEK;

Simon- among the 12 Apostles specially chosen by Jesus and known as the "zealot", which may have meant that he had been of the extreme hard-core Jewish tradition. He preached in Persia where he was martyred.

Jude – This Apostle is always associated with Simon. He was also known as Thaddeus. Almost certainly related to Jesus, he wrote one of the New Testament letters and also preached in Persia where he was martyred. He has become a favourite saint to be invoked when all else fails.
