



## SAINTS OF THIS WEEK-

Sharbel Makhkuf - son of a Lebanese farmer who became a monk & hermit. He was canonised in 1977.

James - one of two Apostles of the same name. He was brother of John and both were sons of Zebedee who had a fishing boat. He was one the three with Jesus when he was arrested. He suffered martyrdom in 44AD, the first among the Apostles. His body is in Compostela, in the north of Spain.

Joachim & Anne - Mentioned in early Christian writings as the parents of the Virgin Mary. Anne, in various forms has been one of the most popular names for girls ever since.

Robert Sutton - Anglican vicar who became a Catholic priest and was martyred at Stafford on 27 July, 1588.

Martha - one of a family of three from Bethany who were among the closest friends of Jesus. He was a frequent visitor to their home. His last public miracle was the raising from the dead of Martha's brother Lazarus.
