

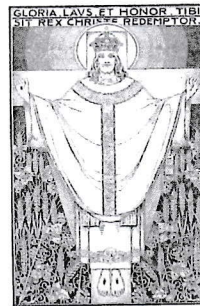

SAINTS & FEASTS THIS WEEK

Our Lady of Walsingham- The traditional feast of England's most important shrine to Mary. It has always been though the original statue was burnt by order the Thomas Cromwell in 1539. There is some evidence that it may have survived by being substituted for another similar statue. Research is currently being carried out.

Cosmas & Damian, Syrian martyrs of the early 4th century. A major basilica in that city is dedicated to them.

Vincent de Paul 1581-1660 - Famous for his foundation of the Daughters of Charity and a priests' order for the relief of the poorest and most deprived of his day. His memory was further enhanced by the foundation of the SVP Society in the 19th century to aid the poor in cities everywhere.

Wenceslaus 907-930- Duke of Bohemia (now called the Czech Republic) he brought Christianity to that country and was killed by his pagan brother in an act of jealousy.

Lorenzo Ruiz - 17th century missionary in Japan who along with many others was put to death for the faith.

Michael, Raphael & Gabriel - The 3 Archangels whose names are mentioned in the Bible.
