THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

This Sunday celebrates the central mystery of the Christian faith. It is a truth that we believe but can never fully understand. Some people would say "what's the point"? The point is fidelity to the words and actions of our Blesses Lord. On so many occasions He identified as Son of His Father in heaven, and revealed and promised another personal communication of energy, intelligence and wisdom. All three manifestations of divine diversity in the manner of their revealed roles in creation and redemption really do constitute One indivisible God. It is an essential attribute of the nature and reality of God that He both is eternally One but at the same time communicates within His inner existence a species of dynamic and creative love which Holy Scripture, God's word revealed over time, designates as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We all share in the reality of the Trinity but it does not produce in us the same outcome. We share in it by mind and memory as well as by self-knowledge, will and creativity. Only the Judaeo-Christian religions dignify humanity with being made in this image and likeness of God. Christianity takes it further with God the Son actually becoming man to die and rise again.
