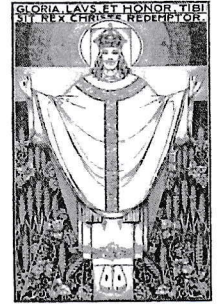

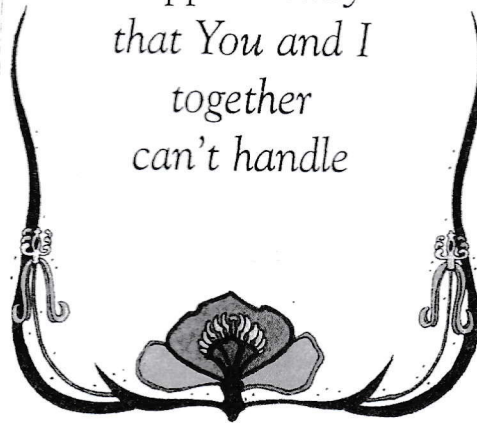

LOOKING BACK AT SOME EVENTS THIS WEEK IN JULY IN PAST YEARS

1588 - The Spanish Armada was sighted on the 29th, off the coast of England.
1799 - Pope Pius VI died a prisoner in France on July 29th, having been driven out of Rome by Napoleon's armies. It was thought at the time to be the end of the Papacy but seven months later a new pope (Pius VII) was elected and reigned long enough to see Napoleon go into exile in 1815.
1907 - Robert Baden - Powell founded the Boy Scouts on 29th.
1981 - More than 700 million people watched the wedding of Prince Charles and Lady Dian Spencer on TV, while more than 1 million lined the streets of London to see the royal carriages go by -29th.
1966 - On the 30th July England won the football World Cup for the first time.
1991 - US President George Bush & Russian leader Mikhail Gorbachev signed a nuclear arms reduction treaty on 31st July.
