SAINTS THIS WEEK

Ignatius of Loyola (1491-1556) Spanish soldier who used the discipline of the army to form the Jesuits along similar lines. The world and global exploration was changing fast during his lifetime and his Order brought Catholicism to a range of countries in Asia and South America. Jesuits also had huge influence in education and scientific exploration.

Alphonsus Ligouri (1696-1787) Living at a time of increasing scepticism and criticism of religion he devoted himself to questions of morality as well as pastoral care among the poorest and the infirm. He founded the Redemptorist Order which became well-known for its successful parish missions and popular devotions to Our Lady and the Blessed Sacrament.

John Mary Vianney (1786-1859) He grew up during the years of the French Revolution and saw its horrors and its campaign against religion until Napoleon brought stability and order. Known as the "Curé of Ars" John Vianney gradually transformed his parish and left a lasting influence on all who met him. He devoted himself to the celebration of Mass and many hours in the confessional. Even today there is something very special about the unspoilt village of Ars.
