SAINTS OF THIS WEEK-

Ignatius Loyola - (1491-1556)- A Basque soldier who while convalescing from serious wounds was inspired to found the Jesuit Order on a military style of organization. It was to become one of the most powerful religious movements in the world.

Alphonsus of Ligouri (1696-1787). An Italian nobleman and lawyer who went on to found the Redemptorists. They used to be in great demand as preachers of missions in parishes.

Eusebius of Vercelli (d.371) A model bishop of the 4th century. He was persecuted for his defence of truth against the Arian heresy.

John Mary Vianney (1786-1859) Known as the "Curé of Ars" his entire priesthood was spent in that parish. He would not have survived so long in most parishes today. Tough and hard-core in his spirituality he changed both the atmosphere of the parish and became the most famous confessor in France. Patron saint of Parish Priests.
