

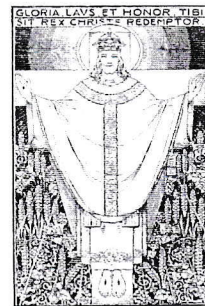

SAINTS & FEASTS THIS WEEK

Therese (1873-1897) Never before has a saint who lived in such hidden and quiet circumstances achieved such fame so soon after her death. Her little book on her own spiritual journey became a best-seller and made her one of the world's favourite saints.

Holy Guardian Angels – As mentioned in the Bible and named by Our Lord in the Gospels they are the invisible and powerful guardians of each of us and of nations too.

Thomas Cantilupe – d. 1275. Sainly priest and lecturer at Oxford, he later became an exemplary Bishop of Hereford, where his tomb is still visible in the cathedral.

Francis- 1182-1226 – Born into a wealthy cloth merchant family, he abandoned all material goods and opted for total poverty. It is not always remembered that he was also inspired to re-build ruined churches and to love of the Mass and devotion to Our Lady. He vowed total obedience to the Church and never did anything without official approval.

Bruno 1035-1101. Little-known German monk who founded the Carthusian Order. It is the strictest of all the religious orders in term of the total silence and solitary life of the monks. The Carthusians were the first religious to be put to death by Henry VIII.
