For those of us whose mothers are no longer with us we recall with affection and gratitude what they did for us and pray that they receive that heavenly reward which makes every gesture of kindness and every sacrifice for others a source of blessing and a sign of grace. May Christ's Holy Mother both protect our families and keep us close to Jesus and to her.
