THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION -

Solemnly defined on 8th December, 1854 this dogma of faith was the culmination of hundreds of years of devotion, discussion and expression in works of art, sacred images, festive celebrations and theological writings. They had all combined to develop this central truth regarding the Virgin Mary. Writing sometime after the event, Dr McHale, Archbishop of Armagh who was present in Rome along with hundreds of other prelates from all over the world was greatly moved by the occasion. He recalled that in the days before the ceremony it had rained in torrents. But on the 8th the sun shone brightly. It was to him a marvellous indication of divine approval.

FEASTS & SAINTS THIS WEEK;

Birinus – Sent by Pope Honorius in 635 to evangelize Wessex (west Saxons). He became first bishop of Dorchester, the centre of the church in this region. His shrine was in the abbey before the time of Henry VIII.

Nicholas – 4th century martyr bishop in Myra (now E Turkey: The original Santa Claus, because of his kindness.

Ambrose– (339-397) Bishop of Milan. A powerful leader and intellectual.

Juan Diego Cuahtlatoatzin- had a vision of Our Lady at Guadalupe in Mexico, now its national shrine.
