## FEASTDAY THIS WEEK;

The Nativity of Our Lady occurs on Friday of this week. Of course we are unsure of the exact date on which Mary was born but a very old tradition from the Middle East links this date with the celebration. It was the custom in ancient times to acknowledge events of her life and intimate relationship to her divine Son by a yearly church festival. This would be a reminder to the faithful at a time when most people could neither read nor write and relied on such festivals to teach and guide them. In the story of Jesus as recorded in the Gospel, the role of Mary is central to understanding his human descent and connections. Thus, it followed logically that Mary's birth was seen as a beginning of the unfolding of God's plan. Her preservation from any taint of sin from her conception prepared her for her unique vocation as Mother of the Saviour of Mankind.
