#### FEASTS & SAINTS THIS WEEK;

Agatha- d. 252, Sicilian virgin martyr, she is mentioned by name in the First Eucharistic Prayer.

Paul Miki – d. 1597, Japanese Jesuit who was martyred with 25 companions at Nagasaki. It a terrible irony that site of the explosion of the A -bomb had many Catholic families.

Josephine Bakhita – Sudanese slave girl who eventually reached Italy where she became a nun, renowned for her dedication and holiness.

Jerome Emiliani- (1486-1537) Soldier who later became a priest, caring for destitute children in Venice.

Scholastica - (480-547) Sister of St Benedict who followed his example of religious life and founded the Benedictine Order of nuns.
