**Perpetua & Felicity** - A noble lady  
and her maid who were thrown to the  
wild beasts in the arena at Carthage in  
N Africa in 203AD. Both were nursing  
children but were not spared on that  
account. Their witness produced many  
converts.

**John of God**- (1495-1550) Founder of  
an Order to care for the sick at  
Granada in Spain. It has houses in  
many others parts pf the world. His  
body lies in Granada Cathedral.

**Frances of Rome** - (1384-1440)  
Mother of six children. She lost two  
children then her husband and had her  
estates confiscated but remained  
faithful to her religion despite these  
trials. She founded areligious order  
dedicated to works of charity and lived  
as its superior.
