SAINTS THIS WEEK

Sixtus- 5th pope after St Peter. He was martyred in a persecution under Emperor Valerian in 258. Dominic - (1170-1221) Great scholar and preacher; he founded the Dominicans dedicated to teaching and preaching against heresy. It became the foremost of all the theological and academic communities in the Church.

Teresa Benedicta (Edith Stein) 1891-1942-Jewish convert, mystic & Carmelite nun. A unique figure of 20th century piety and spirituality.

Laurence - A Roman Deacon of the 3rd century, he was martyred in the same persecution as Pope Sixtus above. Called to deliver up the treasure of the Church, he pointed to the poor people and said: "These are our true treasure".

Clare (1193-1253) Friend and disciple of Francis of Assisi, she followed his example in founding the Order of nuns that bears her name; Poor Clares. Sadly, recent decades have seen a decline in their numbers, like so many religious orders.
