FEASTS & SAINTS THIS WEEK: ALL SAINTS

George Napier (d. 1610). Oxford priest who died for the faith.

Dedication of the Lateran Basilica: Sometimes thought of as less important than St Peter's in Rome, this is in fact the earliest public church, originally built as gift to the Christians by the Emperor Constantine. It is the cathedral church of the Pope. Rebuilt a number of times, the present structure dates largely from the 17th century.

Pope Leo the Great (d.461) One of the best remembered of the popes of the early centuries. His judgement on a theological debate on the natures of Christ (both human and divine) was accepted as definitive at the Council of Chalcedon in 451. He is also remembered as the pope who, with just a few attendants, faced Attila the Hun and persuaded him not to attack and ransack Rome.
