He founded the Bigmingham Oratory, The School (now in Woodcote) and was made a cardinal in 1879 and beatified in 2010 by Pope Benedict XVI. Paulinus. First bishop of York, he was sent from Rome to assist St Augustine of Canterbury in 601. Bl William Howard 1616-1680 – He was a noble victim of the so called "Popish Plot" hysteria, a totally false scare story that was spread by a renegade called Titus Oates, in which innocent Catholics were executed. Pope John XXIII – Elected in 1958 he quickly became a figure of worldwide popularity. He called the Second Vatican Council to address contemporary issues. Wilfrid 634-710. Saxon Bishop of York. Edward the Confessor; 1004-1066- A king renowned for his piety and love of the Church; his reign was troubled by opposition
