THE EIGHTHT DAY OF EASTER

This is a Sunday which has had several names over the Christian centuries. Low Sunday; because it follows the high point of Easter and in the week which followed, the Bishops have one of their two regular annual meetings: Quasimodo Sunday from the first word of the old Latin entry antiphon; Dominica in Albis, from the ancient custom of the newlybaptised wearing their white baptismal robe; Divine Mercy Sunday, more recently from when Pope John Paul II declared it as a special day for that devotion.
