### THE MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS

This year All Saints and All Souls are slightly dislocated by the fact that 1 November falls on a Monday. The bishops' conference has told us to keep All Saints today. However, 1 November is still All Saints' Day in the older calendar so we can double up. All Souls' Day is on Tuesday when there will be the customary 3 Masses: 7.30am at Goring, noon at Woodcote (followed by blessing of graves) and 6pm at Goring. I will bless the Catholic section in the Goring Cemetery on my way back from Woodcote around 1pm. If you would like a grave light they are available for a suggested donation of £5. Envelopes for the departed whom you wish to be remembered are available. Please place them in the boxes. **Mass will be offered for them daily.**
