SERVICE FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY

This week is the beginning of the annual week of prayer for Unity of Christians. To mark it, we are invited to a special service in St Thomas's Church, on Sunday 19th at 4.00pm. Everyone is welcome. Refreshments will be available following the service.

SAINTS' DAYS THIS WEEK

The Church offers us a series of ancient feasts to contemplate in the Unity Week. SS Fabian & Sebastian (a Pope and a soldier from the 3rd century)) remind us that martyrs come from all levels of Christianity. Feast of St Agnes (a virgin martyr from 4ht century) was once a very important festival in the calendar. The popes traditional bless lambs today whose wool will be used to make the white neck ornament (pallium) that archbishops wear when celebrating Mass on big occasions. St Vincent was a Spanish Deacon of the 4th century who was put to death in the last great persecution begun by an edict of Emperor Diocletian (284-305). St Francis de Sales became Bishop of Geneva in 1602. It was time a terrible religious turmoil and division in that city. By his gentle and yet thoroughly clear Catholic teaching he brought thousands back to the faith who had left the Church. One of his sayings was "A spoonful of honey is better than a barrelful of vinegar". The Conversion of St Paul concludes the week. A reminder that even the most hostile of opponents can become the most unlikely converts to the Christ and His truth.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION
